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2014 - 2015 Priorities

Priority #1: All students will receive a variety of instructional methods in all subject areas, to expand and strengthen their approach to learning.

Successes: Our Instructional Committee continued this year and was composed of members from multiple grade levels and subject areas. At our various meetings, we continued to identify the numerous instructional methods that our teachers used throughout each day and began to implement the checklist of those same methods to gather feedback and data. We also created a K-6, school-based bottom lines for reading instruction and subsequent assessment.

Priority #2: All students will be able to think critically in all subject areas by challenging their understandings through intentional assessment.

Successes: Our Assessment Committee continued this year and was composed of members from multiple grade levels and subject areas. At our various meetings, we implemented current and meaningful assessment practices and their connection to the report card. Some examples included "Words Their Way" in ELA, "Leaps & Bounds" in Numeracy, citizenship in social studies and the early development of rubrics for Scientific Inquiry. We also began the development of a school-based, essentials in writing committee.

Priority #3: Our entire Blumenort School community will foster positive relationships, which will in turn enhance our learning environment.

Successes: Our Relationship Committee continued this year and was composed of all staff members. At various staff meetings, we identified areas to improve school-wide relationships. Our focus began with positive relationships within the classroom and continued to our school community. We also provided opportunities for our students to care for their environment and those beyond our community (ESD, FCC Food Drive, WE Serve, etc.). We also improved our communication to the community through an updated school website and created our own school Twitter account.
