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School Planning Priorities for 2014 – 2015

Priority #1 - To enhance students' engagement in their learning through increased use of technology that maintains instructional coherence and integrity.

Initiatives:

- Teachers will be provided with iPads and professional development opportunities to learn to use them and other electronic devices in designing engaging lessons for their students.
- Hanover School Division will provide wifi services that will support effective integration of electronic devices in student learning.
- Students will experience new areas of technology use in their lessons and recognize its effectiveness.

Priority #2 - To develop students' awareness of emotional coping strategies and the ability to recall and draw on them when they encounter difficulties.

Initiatives:

- Guidance teachers will use the 'Second Step' curriculum in Health classes and meetings with students. Special emphasis will be placed on teaching students emotional coping skills.
- Our 'Student Care Team' will meet regularly to develop an action plan to address students' needs.
- Students will learn a 'common language' to process challenging situations they are encountering.

Priority #3 - To deepen student understanding of and appreciation for the cultural diversity of our community, province, country, and world.

Initiatives:

- Assemblies will be used to to expose students to other cultures, and celebrate cultural diversity.
- A school-wide Heritage Fair will require every student to study a culture that is new to them.
- Our social justice group, H40 (Here for Others), will give students opportunities to lead and participate in projects addressing needs locally and globally.
