MEETING SPACE

Try to set up your meeting space in a public area in your house, such as the dining room table. You do want the space to be quiet enough for you to pay attention and have minimal distractions.

RESPECT OTHERS

Your online classes should always be conducted in a respectful manner. Be aware of your facial expressions, the tone in your voice and the words that you say.



VIDEO

You may be on camera, so please be well aware of your surroundings, facial expressions and dress appropriately as you would if you were attending class in person.

RAISE YOUR HAND

When you have questions for your teacher, use the "Raise Your Hand" feature in Google Meet to get the teachers attention. This will help avoid unnecessary noise interruptions while the class is underway.



MUTING

When you are not actively engaged in the conversation in your class, it is a good idea to use the Mute button. This will help keep background noise to a minimum when your online class is underway. When it is your turn to speak, simply unmute yourself. In Google Meet, you can press the Space Bar to mute or unmute yourself.

DRESS CODE AND BEHAVIOUR

Remember, your behaviour and clothing choices for online learning should be the same as in-person learning. Show the same level of courtesy and respect for your teachers and fellow students as if you were in the classroom.
