Policy

The Board acknowledges that individual and organizational donations or sponsorships can support and enrich the division's purpose beyond the existing divisional funding. As a result, HSD schools and parent councils may seek donations or sponsorships from local individuals and businesses to support their fundraising objectives. It is imperative to the board that any donations or sponsorships, whether monetary or capital, align with and support the values, goals, and objectives of the Hanover School Division, and as such, partnerships with individuals or organizations shall:

- Comply with all legislation and Division policies
- Enhance programs and activities
- Support student safety and involvement
- Not subject students to the influence of the individual or organization

Guidelines

The principal will recommend donations or sponsorships (that have been brought forward from the community or parent council) to the Superintendent which will include any considerations for the donations, such as a business name, logo or photograph in school publications.

The Superintendent will review and make the final decisions regarding the consideration given for any donations or sponsorships, and will notify the board of any donations greater than \$10,000.

The consideration of a donation will be limited to a public notification, which does not include naming rights. The public notification of a donation from any source in division publications does not constitute an endorsement of the company or the services/products they offer.
